Information regarding Equine influenza & Hendra virus

Before travelling to Bungendore Show:

- take your own feed and buckets for water and feed
- clean horse transport with disinfectant or soap
- don't bring horses that are sick or off colour
- even though Hendra is rare, know the signs and what to do if you suspect infection and prevent horses from eating feed or drinking water that may be contaminated by body fluids from fruit bats roosting, feeding or flying overhead

At the event:

- waiver forms must be signed and details of all horses completed (name, owner, microchip/ registration number/ horse description, PIC number and last event attended)
- armbands given out to show you have signed the form and registered all horses **MUST BE WORN OR YOU ARE UNABLE TO COMPETE**
- monitor horse health daily
- isolate sick and "in-contact" horses at first sign of illness, report to event organisers who will notify the on-duty vet immediately
- don't share equipment between horses
- wash your hands before & after handling horses
- avoid all contact with other people's horses while at the event and restrict other people from touching yours.
- handle sick horses last or use separate staff

PIC information for NSW horse owners

From 1 September 2012, anyone who keeps horses in NSW will be required to obtain a Property Identification Code (PIC) for the land on which the horses are kept. Even if you only have one horse, you will still need a PIC. PICs are assigned to individual properties and allocated by Livestock Health and Pest Authorities (LHPAs), who maintain the register of more than 90,000 PICs and keep information related to PICs current.

Your obligations

The onus is on individual property and stock owners to comply with PIC requirements.

At the Bungendore Show it is a condition of entry to all equestrian events that exhibitors provide the PIC of the property that the horse normally resides on.

Agricultural Societies Council Of New South Wales Limited and the Bungendore Show (together the Suppliers) advise that participation (including passive participation) in animal handling at an agricultural show contains elements of risk, both obvious and inherent. The handling of animals is a dangerous recreational activity as animals can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially when frightened or hurt.

1. By signing this waiver I acknowledged that:
 - i. participation in animal handling is a recreational service for the purposes of section 139A of the Australian Competition and Consumer Act (Cth) 2010, and also a recreational activity for the purposes of section 5K of the Civil Liability Act (NSW) 2002;
 - ii. participation in animal handling is a hazardous activity and may result in injury, loss, damage or death to me;
 - iii. participation in animal handling requires certain skills and experience. I declare that I have sufficient skills and experience to be able to safely and properly participate in the events;
 - iv. animals can act in a sudden and unpredictable ways, especially if frightened or hurt, or if exposed to loud or unfamiliar noises;
 - v. animal showing events will be held in close proximity to rides and large groups of people, and that there may be loud and unfamiliar noises which can frighten animals;
 - vi. if the event is held outdoors, there are risks to me as a result of the weather conditions, including either extreme hot or cold weather, rain or wind;
 - vii. insects or other animals may cause animals to become frightened and act in an unpredictable way;
 - viii. there is inherent in events involving the handling of animals the risk of suffering injury including injuries caused by animals; and
 - ix. I use the facilities of [name of show society] entirely at my own risk, as I find them and with the prior acceptance of the risk of possible danger to me.
2. If I suffer injury, loss or damage (Loss) while participating in an animal handling event, I will not hold the Suppliers, their employees or agents legally responsible for any Loss I suffer. I will not sue the Suppliers, their employees or agents for any claims, costs, damages or liability. I agree to release the Suppliers and their employees from legal responsibility for the services I have been provided and/or activity I have participated in.
3. I acknowledge and agree that my participation in the event and associated activities is dangerous and may have inherent risks as a result of which personal injury (and sometimes death) may occur. I acknowledge that the event and associated activities carry with them a significant risk of physical harm. I accept and assume all such risks of personal injury or death in anyway whatsoever arising from these activities and hereby waive my individual right to sue the Suppliers for all claims I or my representatives may have for such personal injury or death against the Suppliers in any way whatsoever arising from or in connection with these activities.
4. At the time of participating in the event, I have not been to any degree under the influence of alcohol or illicit drugs.
5. I will not consume any alcohol or illicit drugs while participating in the Event and agree that such use may result in me being excluded from the Event or other events with no entitlement to any refund of money paid for entry to the Suppliers.
6. I agree to be bound by the rules and guidelines of the Agricultural Societies Council of New South Wales Incorporated as varied from time to time.

Entries:

PRE-ENTRY is recommended for all events.

See page four of this schedule for details of how to enter online or on the day.

PRE-ENTRY is recommended for early classes **AS NO CLASS WILL BE HELD UP FOR LATE EXHIBITORS.**

It is the responsibility of all exhibitors to arrive with sufficient time to enter their nominated classes. Prospective exhibitors should note that the Bungendore Show attracts in excess of 1200 horse exhibitors each year so there can be long queues for exhibitor tickets. For a stress free start to your show, it is strongly recommended that you PRE-ENTER. Rings will commence promptly, on time as per the times listed in this schedule.

PRE-ENTRY REFUNDS: On production of a doctor's certificate or a veterinary certificate, 75% of entry fees will be refunded.

Entries can be made on the morning of the Show at the Horse Entry Booth, which is open from 7.00am.

Camping Information: Camping is \$15 per site per night. Powered camp sites are available in the designated horse yard.

Horse Yards: There are 250 steel horse yards on the grounds. All horse yards are uncovered and no yards will be reserved, yards available on a first comes basis. Horse yards are **available free of charge.**

Owners of Stallions are expected to be considerate of other exhibitors and to yard their stallions appropriately.

No electric fences are allowed on the showground.

Dogs: All dogs are to be on leashes and secured at all times. All dog owners are expected to pick up after their dogs.

Notice to Exhibitors:

Helmets: All exhibitors MUST WEAR an Australian Standard Approved Safety helmet when mounted while on the grounds of the Bungendore Show. This includes Hack & Australian Stock Horse Rings.

Exhibitors in the Horse Section are advised that competitors in ring events will be called to the class by the Announcer or Ring Steward. Failure of an exhibitor to report to the ring marshalling steward when called for a class shall render him or her liable to disqualification from that class.

Lateness to the Ring: Competitors must be ready when called. Once judging has commenced, a competing horse shall not be led, ridden or driven into or out of the judging ring without the permission of the judge and/or the Ringmaster or Chief Steward.

Leaving The Ring: If a led horse should drag or escape its handler or a ridden or driven horse take control of or unseat its rider and leave the ring, it is usually disqualified from the class.

Reserve Champion Awards:

An exhibitor (or rider) placed second in a class to an exhibitor (or rider) selected as Champion, shall become eligible for a Reserve Champion ribbon, providing such second prize winner is available to enter the judging ring immediately after the Judge has selected and decorated the Champion. Exhibitors are warned that our ring program does not allow for any delay in the judging rings and stewards are not required to wait for

exhibitors who fail to present their exhibits to the Judge when called.

District/Local Classes: Horses and/or riders must have been resident for at least three months prior to the show within a 50 kilometre radius of the Showground.

Drug Testing: An exhibitor shall not administer and shall not allow to be administered to their exhibit any drug or substance listed as a prohibited substance under EA rules. It is the intention of this rule that all animals shall perform on their merits without the aid of drugs which will affect the conduct, performance or appearance of the animal.

Offensive Behaviour: Offensive behaviour will not be tolerated from any person at the Bungendore PA&H Society Show. The BPA&H Society will be the sole judge of what constitutes offensive behaviour, but it may include but is not limited to making loud comments, the use of foul language or the intimidation or bullying of exhibits, exhibitors, officials, volunteers or spectators.

Cruelty to Animals: No exhibitor shall engage in or be knowingly involved in cruelty to any animal. The BPA&H Society will be the sole judge of what constitutes cruelty. Any case of cruelty must be reported immediately to the Chief Horse Steward.

HORSE SECTION - Regulations

***All competition at this show is governed by these regulations and by the Agricultural Societies Council of NSW Rules for Discipline in Horse Sections at Shows which can be viewed at www.agshowsnsw.org.au.**

Should it become necessary for the ASC Disciplinary Committee to open an inquiry into any aspect of competition in this Horse Section, this Society will support any penalty imposed by that Committee as a result of the inquiry and will support penalties resulting from enquiries arising from Horse Sections at other NSW shows.

INDEMNITY AND WAIVER FORMS:

The Horse Committee will take all care in managing the Section, but competitors taking part in this Horse Section do so at their own risk. Each adult competitor must, before competing, complete and sign a form indemnifying the Bungendore Show and waiving any claims against the Society for any injury sustained in competition or for loss or damage to the competitor's property or damage caused by the competitor or his/her animal(s) at the Show. A similar form must also be completed and signed by a parent or guardian for each competitor who is under 18 years of age. ALSO, on each Waiver, each horse with which the competitor is involved in competition at the Show must be listed together with the Property Identification Code (PIC) of the property from which the horse came to the Show.

Refusal of Entry/Alteration of Schedule: The committee reserves the right to refuse an entry without assigning any reason for doing so and to alter the schedule to meet emerging circumstances.

Judge's Decision/Discretion: The judge is empowered to withhold any or all prizes in any class where the exhibits are, in his/her opinion, unworthy of the prize, and at all

times the judge's decision will be final. A judge has the discretion to ask that a led or performance exhibit and handler / rider / driver be ordered to leave the ring if he/she considers the animal is unruly and/or likely to cause an accident.

Novice Hack, Galloway, Pony: A Novice has not won a First Place at any Show.

Show Hunters: Horses in these classes may not also compete in Ridden Hack, Galloway or Pony classes.

Ridden Hack, Galloway, Pony: Horses in these classes may not also compete in Show Hunter classes.

Stallions: Stallions must be wearing a bit at all times when being led and must be under the control of a person 17 years of age or older. They must be supervised at all times and securely fastened when tied to the outside of a truck or float. They are not eligible to compete in ridden classes unless their eligibility is specifically stated in the schedule.

Ponies with Adult Riders: Ponies may be ridden by adults unless otherwise stated in the schedule.

Horse Measuring: No official measuring will take place at the show, but, if a question about height arises, proof of height may be required. In the absence of proof, a decision will be at the absolute discretion of the Ring Master or Chief Steward.

Breed Registration: Registration documents for horses in breed classes must be produced when required by a Steward.

Attire: Competitors must be appropriately attired for the competition in which they are competing.

Footwear: All competitors must wear appropriate footwear when leading or riding a horse. When riding, the footwear must enable removal of the foot from the stirrup.

Cruelty: Persons who are considered by the Ringmaster or Chief Steward to be abusive or cruel to a horse will be expelled from the ground. No horse will be permitted to compete if, in the opinion of the Ringmaster or Chief Steward, it is in poor health or condition.

Approaching Judges: No exhibitor or associate will initiate conversation with a judge on judging day, before, during or after judging except through the Ringmaster or Chief Steward.

Prohibited Relationship: No competitor will present for judging before a judge with whom he/she has a family relationship, has or has recently had a personal relationship or has had horse related business dealings during the past twelve months.

Coaching: Any person detected coaching a competitor while that competitor is being judged may be removed from the Showground.

Proper Conduct: Any exhibitor or associate who behaves offensively on the Showground will be expelled from the ground, may be banned from the show in future and may be banned by other Societies.

Protests: A protest or complaint against any exhibit or exhibitor may be lodged verbally with the Ringmaster or Chief Steward no later than ten minutes after the judging of the exhibit or exhibitor. The Ringmaster or Chief Steward must be provided with the exact nature of the complaint and act, if necessary, to maintain competitive fairness. The Ringmaster or Chief Steward may choose to refer the matter to the Protests Committee, which shall comprise the President of the Society, or a Vice President and two other members of the General Committee. A protest or complaint or an appeal against the decision of the Ringmaster or Chief Steward may be lodged in writing with the Secretary no later than 10 pm on the day of judging. Such protest, complaint or appeal shall be accompanied by a **deposit of \$50** which shall be forfeited if the protest, complaint or appeal proves to be frivolous or vexatious. A matter lodged this way shall be dealt with by the Protests Committee within 24 hours of lodgement and the decision of the Protest Committee shall be final. NB: No protest or complaint will be considered if it refers simply to a judge's decision.

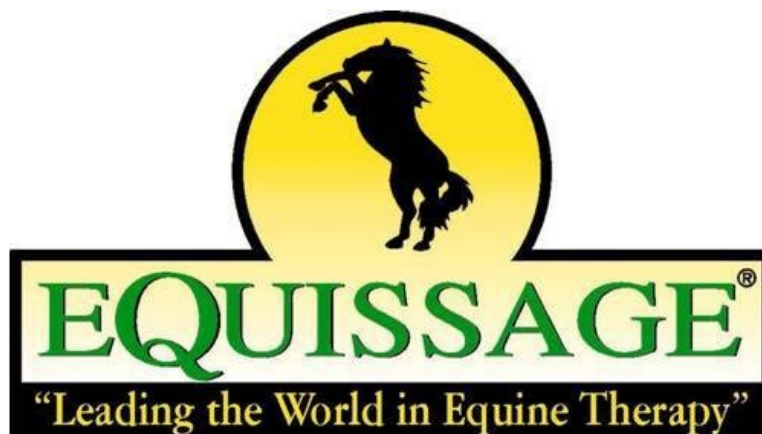

PRIZE MONEY

60% of the entry money pool will be added to the Prize Pool **for each race.**

For example, if 20 horse/rider combinations enter the Cliff Sillis Open Flag Race, the Prize Money will increase by 60% of the entry money pool as follows:

1st - \$100 + \$60 from entry pool = \$160 total prize money

2nd - \$60 + \$40 = \$100

3rd - \$20 + \$20 = \$40

Riders riding multiple horses:

If a rider qualifies two or more horses for the semi-finals or the final, the rider can nominate another rider to ride their horse(s), and if the horse makes the final the rider can choose to ride that horse in the final. A horse cannot have multiple riders other than described.

EVENT RULES

Flag Race

Each competitor must leave the pegs on his/her right and take the furthest flag from the furthest peg first and place it in the cask/bucket/bag at the start line, then second furthest peg and continue in that sequence. The cask/bucket/bag can either be turned out or in.

Elimination occurs if:

1. A competitor interferes with another - same rule as for the Bending Race.
2. A competitor causes more than one (1) false start.
3. A competitor fails to correct a fallen cask or dropped flag. A fallen cask must be re-erected before the rider continues. A dropped flag must be picked up and the rider must re-mount before placing the flag in the cask.
4. Hitting the horse with a flag.
5. Picking up the peg with the flag.
