

HORSE SECTION – 2017 BUNGENDORE SHOW

Entries:

ON THE DAY

\$5.00 per CLASS for all Rings, excluding the Pony Club Ring - Pony Club Ring 9 – \$2.00 per CLASS

Entries for Rings 1 to 11 and Sporting can be made on the morning of the Show at the Horse Entry Booth (No. 6 on the Show Map, which is open from 7.00am Show Day).

ENTRY AT THE GATE

General Show Admission - \$15 PER ADULT

(ADULTS are 13 years & over)

Children under 13 years free

Seniors Card Holder - \$10

FAMILY PASS - \$35 (2 Adults and 3 children up to 17 years)

Notice to Exhibitors:

NO CLASS WILL BE HELD UP FOR LATE EXHIBITORS. It is the responsibility of all exhibitors to arrive with sufficient time to enter their nominated classes. Prospective exhibitors should note that the Bungendore Show attracts more than 1200 horse exhibitors each year. Rings will commence promptly, on time as per the times listed in the schedule.

THERE ARE NO REFUNDS ON THE DAY FOR MISSED CLASSES.

The TICKET BOOTH is open all day at the show, so extra tickets can be purchased throughout the day.

PARKING:

FREE PARKING is available in the areas shown on this map.

Exhibitors who park in NO PARKING areas will be asked to move. Please note that ringside parking for horse exhibitors is not guaranteed, particularly if the ground condition is affected by heavy rain.

HORSE YARDS: All horse yards are steel, uncovered and the majority have chain closures. No yards will be reserved, yards available on a first comes basis. Horse yards are available free of charge. Owners of Stallions are expected to be considerate of other exhibitors and to yard their stallions appropriately. No electric fences are allowed on the showground.

DOGS: All dogs are to be on leashes and secured at all times.

HELMETS: All exhibitors MUST WEAR an Australian Standard Approved Safety helmet when mounted while on the grounds of the Bungendore Show. This includes Hack & Australian Stock Horse Rings.

NOTICE OF A CLASS: Exhibitors in the Horse Section are advised that competitors in ring events will be called to the class **by the Ring Steward**. Every Ring has a **Class RING COUNTER**, operated by the Ring Steward. Exhibitors in each class should check the Class RING COUNTER regularly. The Ring Steward will be giving a warning call, followed by an interval of a few minutes, then a final call will be made for the class. Failure of an exhibitor to report to the ring marshalling steward when called for a class shall render him or her liable to disqualification from that class. Should an exhibitor report late for the judging of a class, the exhibitor concerned shall only be allowed to enter the judging ring at the discretion of the Judge. Unless otherwise specified, stallions may only compete in stallion classes.

DEFINITIONS

Reserve Champion Awards: An exhibitor (or rider) placed second in a class to an exhibitor (or rider) selected as Champion, shall become eligible for a Reserve Champion

ribbon, providing such second prize winner is available to enter the judging ring immediately after the Judge has selected and decorated the Champion. Exhibitors are warned that our ring program does not allow for any delay in the judging rings and stewards are not required to wait for exhibitors who fail to present to the Judge when called.

LOCAL: All events identified as "LOCAL" are for exhibitors (horse, handler & rider) who reside within a 40km radius of Bungendore.

NOVICE: Novice events are for horses that have not won a FIRST ribbon at an Agricultural Show.

CLASSES: Ponies or Horses must nominate in either **Show Hunter Classes or Hack Classes**. Ponies or Horses nominated as Show Hunters may compete in the Local classes.

REGISTRATION: Horses in appropriate classes must be registered with their Breed Society(s) and copies of Registration must be available for presentation on the day if requested by the relevant Judge or the Chief Horse Steward.

DRUG TESTING: An exhibitor shall not administer and shall not allow to be administered to their exhibit any drug or substance listed as a prohibited substance under EA rules. It is the intention of this rule that all animals shall perform on their merits without the aid of drugs which will affect the conduct, performance or appearance of the animal.

OFFENSIVE BEHAVIOUR: Offensive behaviour will not be tolerated from any person at the Bungendore PA & H Society Show. The BPA&H Society will be the sole judge of what constitutes offensive behaviour, but it may include but is not limited to making loud comments, the use of foul language or the intimidation or bullying of exhibits, exhibitors, officials, volunteers or spectators.

CRUELTY TO ANIMALS: No exhibitor shall engage in or be knowingly involved in cruelty to any animal. The BPA & H Society will be the sole judge of what constitutes cruelty. Any case of cruelty must be reported immediately to the Chief Horse Steward.

AWARDS: Rosettes or ribbons awarded to 3rd place in all rings. Champion, Reserve and Supreme Sashes and Special awards as indicated in the Schedule.
