RING OPERATION

Start times vary across rings - check this schedule for start times for individual rings

Due to the number of rings in operation there are likely to be clashes between some classes. Every attempt has been made to eliminate clashes where possible. However, due to horses having multiple registrations and the fact that as many as eleven classes run at the same time across different rings, it is not possible to eliminate all class clashes. Therefore, where these occur, the Exhibitor will have to make a choice between one class and the other. Your cooperation is appreciated.

THERE IS NO DEDICATED HORSE ANNOUNCER. Competitors will be required to monitor their chosen Rings, watch the ring counters and listen to the Ring Stewards announcements. Rings will **not** be held up unless the Judge deems that it is prudent to do so.

EXHIBITOR PARKING

To ensure a hassle-free start to your showing day, please familiarise yourself with the Ring layout and parking options. Exhibitors who park in NO PARKING areas will be asked to move. Please note that ringside parking for horse exhibitors is not guaranteed, particularly if the ground condition is affected by rain.

RING SIDE PARKING

Rings 1 through to 5 will be on the far side of the main grounds – furthest away from the Horse Entry Gate (Gate 2). This will also position Ring 5 – Heavy Horses, closer to the Harness Ring 11, we hope for the convenience of exhibitors wishing to exhibit in both Ring 5 and 11.

There will be Port-a-loos and a water cart near Rings 1 to 5. Exhibitors in these rings are encouraged to park on the far side near these rings (edge of the cross country course) **if the ground conditions allow.**

The Show Committee reserves the right to restrict the movement of vehicles on the show grounds in the event of substantial rainfall in the days leading up to the Show. A person must not disobey a reasonable direction given by the Show Society, or a person acting under an authority, about driving, moving, parking or using a motor vehicle on the showgrounds.

EXHIBIT NUMBERS

Exhibit Numbers will be supplied at the Horse Section Booth. These can be worn on bridles, breastplates or saddle cloths. Each horse must clearly display the same exhibit number in all events/classes for the duration of the show. Exhibits without a number will be prohibited from entering a ring to compete in a class. The Ring Steward's decision is final in this respect.

For a stress-free start to your show, it is strongly recommended that you PRE-ENTER. Rings will commence promptly, on time as per the times listed in this schedule.

ENTRY REFUNDS: On production of a doctor's certificate or a veterinary certificate, 75% of entry fees will be refunded.

THERE ARE NO REFUNDS ON THE DAY FOR MISSED CLASSES.

The TICKET BOOTH is open all day at the show, so extra tickets can be purchased throughout the day.

Entries for Rings 1 to 11 and Sporting can be made on the morning of the Show at the Horse Entry Booth, which is open from 7.00am.

HORSE YARDS

All horse yards are steel, uncovered and the majority half have chain closures. No yards will be reserved, yards available on a first comes basis. Horse yards are available free of charge. Owners of Stallions are expected to be considerate of other exhibitors and to yard their stallions appropriately. No electric fences are allowed on the showground. **All dogs are to be on leashes and secured at all times.**

Notice to Exhibitors:

HELMETS

All exhibitors **MUST WEAR** an Australian Standard Approved Safety helmet when mounted while on the grounds of the Bungendore Show. This includes Hack & Australian Stock Horse Rings.

NOTICE OF A CLASS

Exhibitors in the Horse Section are advised that competitors in ring events will be called to the class **by the Ring Steward**. Every Ring has a **Class RING COUNTER**, operated by the Ring Steward. Exhibitors in each class should check the Class RING COUNTER regularly. The Ring Steward will be giving a warning call, followed by an interval of a few minutes, then a final call will be made for the class. Failure of an exhibitor to report to the ring marshalling steward when called for a class shall render him or her liable to disqualification from that class. Should an exhibitor report late for the judging of a class, the exhibitor concerned shall only be allowed to enter the judging ring at the discretion of the Judge. Unless otherwise specified, stallions may only compete in stallion classes.

DEFINITIONS

Reserve Champion Awards:

An exhibitor (or rider) placed second in a class to an exhibitor (or rider) selected as Champion, shall become eligible for a Reserve Champion ribbon, providing such second prize winner is available to enter the judging ring immediately after the Judge has selected and decorated the Champion. Exhibitors are warned that our ring program does not allow for any delay in the judging rings and stewards are not required to wait for exhibitors who fail to present their exhibits to the Judge when called.

LOCAL: All events identified as "LOCAL" are for exhibitors (horse, handler & rider) who reside within a 40km radius of Bungendore.

NOVICE: Novice events are for horses that have not won a FIRST ribbon at an Agricultural Show.

Ponies or Horses must nominate in either

Show Hunter Classes or Hack Classes

Ponies or Horses nominated as Show Hunters may however compete in the Local classes. Horses in appropriate classes must be registered with their Breed Society(s) and copies of Registration must be available for presentation on the day if requested by the relevant Judge or the Chief Horse Steward.

DRUG TESTING

An exhibitor shall not administer and shall not allow to be administered to their exhibit any drug or substance listed as a prohibited substance under EA rules. It is the intention of this rule that all animals shall perform on their merits without the aid of drugs which will affect the conduct, performance or appearance of the animal.

OFFENSIVE BEHAVIOUR

Offensive behaviour will not be tolerated from any person at the Bungendore PA & H Society Show. The BPA&H Society will be the sole judge of what constitutes offensive behaviour, but it may include but is not limited to making loud comments, the use of foul language or the intimidation or bullying of exhibits, exhibitors, officials, volunteers or spectators.

CRUELTY TO ANIMALS

No exhibitor shall engage in or be knowingly involved in cruelty to any animal. The BPA & H Society will be the sole judge of what constitutes cruelty. Any case of cruelty must be reported immediately to the Chief Horse Steward.
