BEEF CATTLE SECTION

Entry Fee: \$10 PER ANIMAL PER CLASS

Cattle to be stalled by 9.30am

Judging to commence at 10.00am.

Entries and payment can be made on show day, however please forward expressions of interest to heatherearney@outlook.com

All cattle must be accompanied by a certificate attesting that they have been tested with an antigen test for bovine pestivirus (BVD), in order to demonstrate that they are not persistently infected with this virus.

Note that this requirement is necessary to comply with guidelines received from the Agricultural Societies Council of NSW, with the intention of protecting stud breeders and the integrity of country shows. Please ensure that only cattle that have been tested negative are unloaded from vehicles. We regret that any untested cattle will be required to be removed from the beef cattle show facilities immediately.

All cattle must also be accompanied by a National Cattle Health Declaration form (October 2017 version) and a National Vendor Declaration (C 0413) or Transported Stock Statement (TSS) prior to entries being accepted. All cattle must possess a National Livestock Identification System (NLIS) device such as an NLIS approved electronic ear tag.

Entry to the showground is to be prior to 9:00am on show day.

Prize money is GST inclusive and is to be collected from the Show Secretary on show day.

Class A – European breeds

Class B – British breeds

Class C - Miniature

Class D – Any other breed not mentioned*

***This is a stand-alone Class. However if there is enough interest with any particular breed not mentioned above, we may add this breed as a separate class.**

The above will comprise the following classes in breed class order. Bulls will be judged first, followed by females. In-class order will be from youngest to oldest.

Champions will be conducted at the end of the age groups for that champion. Champions will be awarded per breed.

1. Bull under 12 months.

2. Bull 12 months to under 24 months

3. Bull over 24 months to under 36 months.
