**Bungendore Show Grounds, Mathews Lane, Bungendore**

- **Pre-entry on Global Entries Online-** \$6 a class for show rings and sporting or \$45 day ticket. Dressage tests \$25, pre-entry only. Bungendore Showground Trust horse levy \$10 per horse. **Tickets on the day** \$8 for show rings and sporting or \$55 day ticket.
- A day ticket is per horse and rider combination and covers ring classes and sporting, excludes dressage
- No gate entry fee
- Camping and yards available. Camping **MUST** be pre-booked through Global- \$30 powered, \$20 unpowered. Yards are free but please leave them clean.
- **Results from Rings 2 (Breeds) and 4 (Open Hack/Hunter) will be forwarded to RAS.** Riders must choose between Rings 1 (Gymkhana) and 4, the same horse and rider combination may not compete in both.
- Property Identification Code (PIC)- must be provided (no PIC, no entry). Showground PIC is NE083239 for all Horse Movements

**Dressage:** Prep1 (2023), Prelim 1.1 (2023), Novice 2.1 (2023)

**Sporting** -Bending, Flag race, Barrels, Keyhole, Egg and spoon, Walk, trot & lead, Obstacle

**Fancy Dress-** 'Winter Wonderland' theme and Open- all welcome (free entry)

**Novelties-** hairiest pony, longest mane and tail, best trick (free entry)

## Frequently Asked Questions

### **What does a day ticket cover?**

A day ticket is one per horse and rider combination. It includes all ring classes and sporting. It EXCLUDES dressage, you will need to pay separately to do a dressage test. If you have a second horse or rider you can either buy a second day ticket, or just individual tickets.

### **What are the 'Have a go' classes and what should I enter?**

These are classes for nervous nellys and those new to showing who need some extra instruction on ring etiquette, how to do a workout etc. The classes are walk and trot only. The other classes in Ring 1 are aimed at more confident riders who can canter on the ring. Jackets and plaiting are optional in Ring 1.

### **Help- I don't have a show outfit! What do I wear?**

Pony club or adult riding club uniform is very acceptable in all classes. You are also welcome to wear neat riding clothes, boots and helmet.

It is expected that horses and riders in Ring 4 will be turned out as per regular show requirements.

### **I want to try dressage but only have a stock saddle- can I enter?**

Yes, we are encouraging people to try a new discipline so please come along. There are rules on which bit you can use so please contact us if you are unsure.

### **My pony looks like a yak! Can I still come?**

Yes! And we have a 'hairiest horse/pony' class just for you!

### **I'm short a quallie for Sydney or Canberra Royal, can you help me?**

Yes! Ring 2 (breeds) and 4 (hack/hunter) have been accepted by RAS as a royal qualifier event. You can use these PLUS your wins at Bungendore Show. Classes in Ring 4 may be split at the judge's discretion. Please ensure you provide your correct details to the steward for when we report the results to RAS.

### **What if I'm a member of pony club and adult riding club?**

You must choose between the PC and ARC classes and must be a financial member.

### **I have a disability and want to try showing**

You don't need to be registered with RDA or have a classification we will warmly welcome you. Classes may be split on the day. Sporting races may be adjusted and extra classes added. Please get in touch with any accessibility requirements.

### **I've had an amazing day and want to be involved in Bungendore Show on 25 October, how do I find out more?**

## Rules & Regulations

ASC Rules for Discipline in Horse Section at Shows (Wording from the AgShowsNSW horse regulations overrules anything written on the Bungendore Show Society website, schedules or Global Entries Online. AgShowsNSW Horse Regulations is what is followed by the Bungendore Show Society for their horse events.)

\*All competition at this show is governed by these regulations and by the Agricultural Societies Council of NSW Rules for Discipline in Horse Sections at Shows which can be viewed at [www.agshowsnsw.org.au](http://www.agshowsnsw.org.au). Should it become necessary for the AgShows NSW Disciplinary Committee to open an inquiry into any aspect of competition in this Horse Section, this Society will support any penalty imposed by that Committee as a result of the inquiry, and will support penalties resulting from enquiries arising from Horse Sections at other NSW shows.

**COMPETITION RULES** All Horse Competitions will be conducted under approved Peak Body Rules and Regulations.

**INDEMNITY AND WAIVER FORMS:** The Horse Committee will take all care in managing the Section, but competitors taking part in this Horse Section do so at their own risk. Each adult competitor must, before competing, complete and sign a form indemnifying Bungendore Show Society and waiving any claims against the Society for any injury sustained in competition or for loss or damage to the competitor's property or damage caused by the competitor or his/her animal(s) at the Show. A similar form must also be completed and signed by a parent or guardian for each competitor who is under 18 years of age. ALSO, all competitors must complete a Horse Health Declaration, each horse with which the competitor has brought onto the Showgrounds must be listed together with the Property Identification Code (PIC) of the property from which the horse came to the Show. If the Show Society has introduced online entries, it is possible to electronically sign a Waiver and Horse Health Declaration (by ticking a box) at point of entry.

**Under Saddle Age Limit:** AgShows NSW recommends a lower age limit of 3 years of age (as at the date of the competition) for leading rein and 5 years of age for independent riding.

**Refusal of Entry/Alteration of Schedule/Prizes:** The committee reserves the right to refuse an entry without assigning any reason for doing so and to alter the schedule to meet emerging circumstances. The Society is not responsible for the non-delivery of sponsor's trophies/prizes. Should there be any reason to suspect that any exhibit is either diseased or dangerous, the Society reserves the right to isolate, refuse entry to and/or remove the exhibit from the ground at the expense of the exhibitor.

**Judge's Decision/Discretion:** The judge is empowered to withhold any or all prizes in any class where the exhibits are, in his/her opinion, unworthy of the prize, and always the judge's decision will be final. A judge has the discretion to ask that a led or performance exhibit and handler / rider / driver be ordered to leave the ring if he/she considers the animal is unruly and/or likely to cause an accident.

**Novice Class Eligibility:** A Novice has not won a First Place at any Show/ gymkhana in a similar class.

**Ridden Show Hunters and Ridden Show Hacks:** At the beginning of each calendar year an exhibitor MUST choose the category for their exhibit, EITHER Show Hunter or Show Hack, when competing at an AgShows NSW Affiliated Agricultural Show or supplementary event.

**Ridden Show Hunters: Hack, Galloway, Pony:** Horses in Show Hunter classes may not also compete in Ridden Show Hack classes.

**Ridden Show Hacks – Hack, Galloway, Pony:** Horses in Show Hack classes may not also compete in Show Hunter classes.

**Stallions:** Stallions must be wearing a bit at all times when being led and must be under the control of a person 17 years of age or older. They must be always supervised and securely fastened when tied to the outside of a truck or float.

**Ponies with Adult Riders:** Ponies may be ridden by adults unless otherwise stated in the schedule.

**Lateness to the Ring:** Competitors must be ready when called. Once judging has commenced, a competing horse shall not be led, ridden, or driven into or out of the judging ring without the permission of the judge and/or the Ringmaster or Chief Steward.

**Leaving The Ring:** If a led horse should drag or escape its handler or a ridden or driven horse take control of or unseat its rider and leave the ring, it is usually disqualified from the class.

**Horse Measuring:** No official measuring will take place at the show, but, if a question about height arises, proof of height may be required. In the absence of proof, a decision will be at the absolute discretion of the Ring Master or Chief Steward.

**Breed Registration:** Registration documents for horses in breed classes must be produced when required by a Steward. It is the competitor/owner's responsibility to ensure relevant memberships for their exhibits Breed society or registry is financial at time of competition.

**Attire:** Competitors must be appropriately attired for the competition in which they are competing.

**Helmets:** Every rider is encouraged to wear a safety helmet compliant with the current Australian Standard. Riders under 18 years must wear such a helmet. Some EA affiliated events require Rider's helmets to be tagged prior to competition.

**Footwear:** All competitors must wear appropriate footwear when leading or riding a horse. When riding, the footwear must enable removal of the foot from the stirrup.

**Cruelty:** Persons who are considered by the Ringmaster or Chief Steward to be abusive or cruel to a horse will be expelled from the ground. No horse will be permitted to compete if, in the opinion of the Ringmaster or Chief Steward, it is in poor health or condition.

**Drugs:** Drug testing may be carried out at this show. Any competitor found to have breached the AgShows NSW disputes & disciplinary regulation will be investigated by the AgShows NSW disciplinary committee.

**Approaching Judges:** No exhibitor or associate will initiate conversation with a judge on judging day, before, during or after judging except through the Ringmaster or Chief Steward.

**Prohibited Relationship:** No competitor will present for judging before a judge with whom he/she has a family relationship, has, or has recently had a personal relationship or has had horse related business dealings during the past twelve months.

**Coaching:** Any person detected coaching a competitor while that competitor is being judged may be removed from the Showground.

**Proper Conduct:** Any person who behaves offensively on the Showground may be expelled from the ground. The matter may be investigated by the Society or/and the AgShows NSW Disciplinary committee and penalties may be imposed.

**Protests:** In the spirit of a relaxed, happy day no protests will be entered into. Any serious concerns can be raised with the Chief Steward for an agreeable solution.

**Veterinary Costs:** In the case of an exhibit requiring veterinary inspection/treatment whilst at this event exhibitors agree that all costs incurred are their responsibility.

**Age of Horses:** The age of all horses shall be calculated from 1st August in the year in which it was foaled.

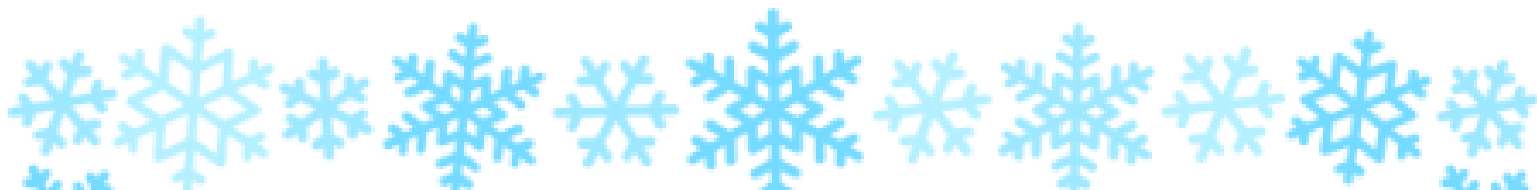

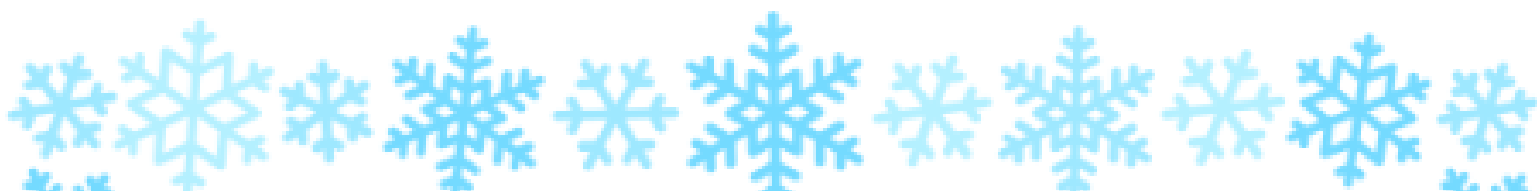
