CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entries

- Entries to be submitted online via Showday by midnight on Friday 16 October 2026.
- Entry fee is \$4 unless otherwise stated with payment to be made in Showday at time of entry.
- Lamb definition: not to show 2 permanent teeth.
- All exhibits must be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor.
- No sheep to compete in more than one class except for groups and young handlers.
- The following documentation must be emailed to sheep@bungendoreshow.com.au at the time of entry:
 - National Sheep Health Declaration

Biosecurity

- All sheep must have an NLIS ear tag showing Property Identification Code (PIC). Lambs born after 1/1/2025 must have an NLIS EID tag. EID tags will be scanned during the show for recording in the NLIS system.
- A National Vendor Declaration (NVD) or Travelling Stock Statement (TSS) must accompany all sheep to the grounds and be provided to the Sheep Steward before or on arrival.
- No sheep may be penned or compete if infected with Footrot, any external or internal parasite, or any other signs of disease.
- All rams must be from Brucellosis Accredited flocks.

Participating in the sheep show

- All sheep to be delivered to the sheep shed and penned with vehicles moved away to the sheep and cattle parking area by 8.30am.
- Bedding straw will be provided.
- Judging will commence at approximately 9.30am.
- All exhibits must remain on display until the show closes.
- All exhibits must have no more than 12 months wool.
- All exhibitors must provide own handlers.
- All exhibitors participating in the sheep show need to pay the show gate entry fee. Tickets can be purchased online from the Bungendore Show website.
- All exhibitors and handlers must sign a [risk waiver form](#) and provide it to the Sheep Steward before or on arrival.

GROUPS

Merinos, Australian and British Breeds and Black and Coloured sheep are eligible for the group classes. Sheep may have been entered in another class.

To be judged on uniformity, conformation, trueness of breed and type.

The champion rams from all sections are eligible to compete. Ribbon and prize.

ROYAL HOTEL BUNGENDORE GRAND CHAMPION EWE

The champion ewes from all sections are eligible to compete. Ribbon and prize.

LAKE GEORGE HOTEL SUPREME EXHIBIT SHEEP

The grand champion ram and ewe are eligible to compete. Ribbon, prize and garland.

YOUNG JUDGES AND HANDLERS

Young Handlers

Young handlers classes are judged on the skills and knowledge displayed by the handlers when they bring a sheep out into the show ring for judging. The sheep used may be borrowed on the day from a breeder competing in the sheep breed classes by prior arrangement. This is a way to build sheep handling skills. The judge may offer handling tips and ideas at the end of the judging.

Class 16092 PeeWee Handler

Up to 10 years of age on day of show.

Class 16093 Junior Handler

10 to 15 years of age on day of show.

Class 16094 Senior Handler

16 to 20 years of age on day of show.

Young Judges

Young judges classes are judged on the skills and knowledge displayed by the young judges when they assess a sheep lineup. The sheep may include a variety of wool types. This is a way to build sheep judging skills and knowledge of sheep. The judge may offer tips and ideas at the end of the judging.

Class 16095 Peewee Judge

Up to 10 years of age on day of show.

Class 16096 Junior Judge

10 to 15 years of age on day of show.

Class 16097 Senior Judge

16 to 20 years of age on day of show.
